
#### <u>CO-CURRICULAR : A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES</u>




















#### **PET DAY - 11 APRIL 2025**


Techno India Group Public School, Nabagram Konnagar celebrates World Pet Day in our Balvatika Sector with love, laughter, and lots of wagging tails!
