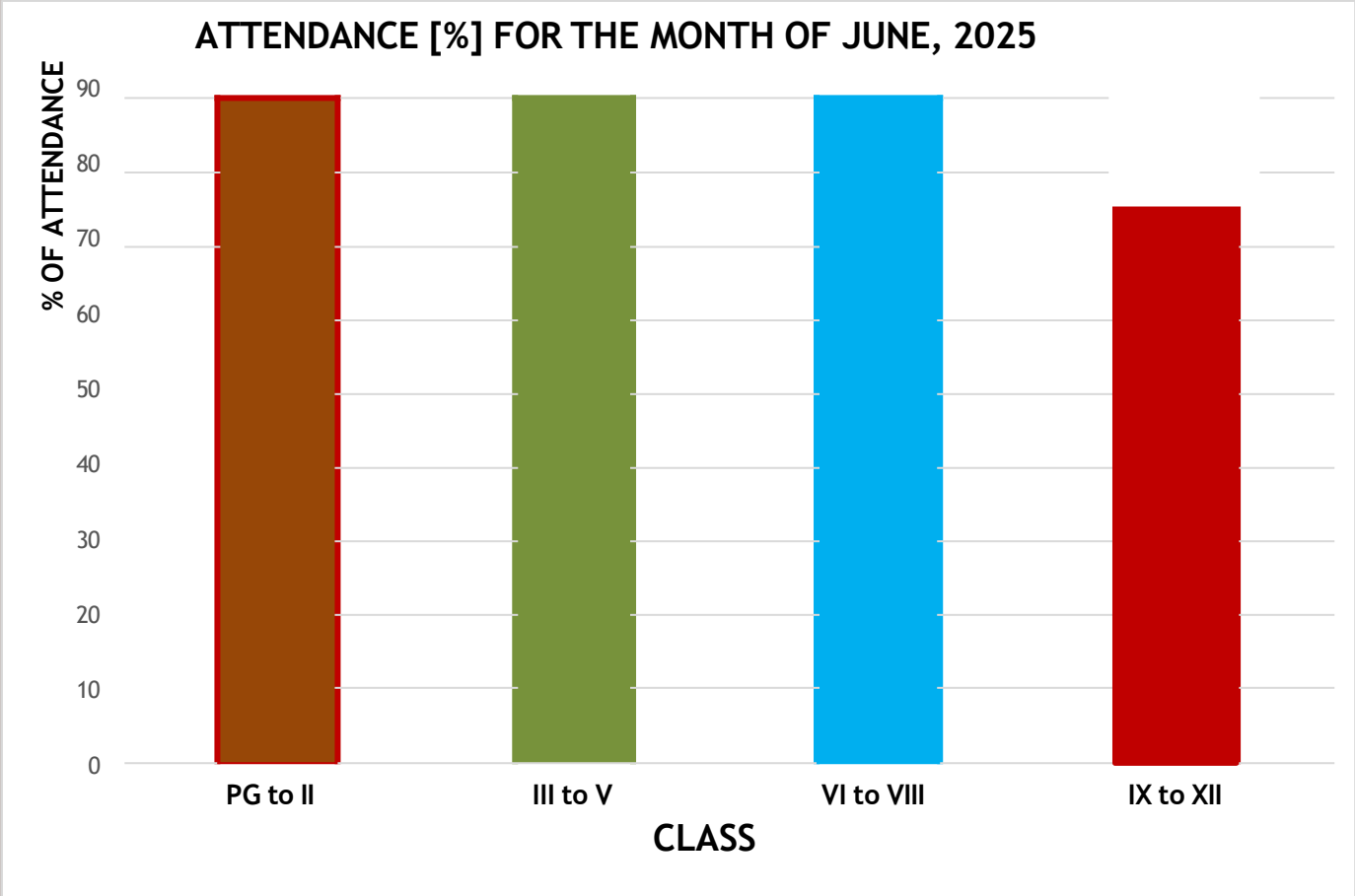
CO-CURRICULAR : A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES

Watering plants

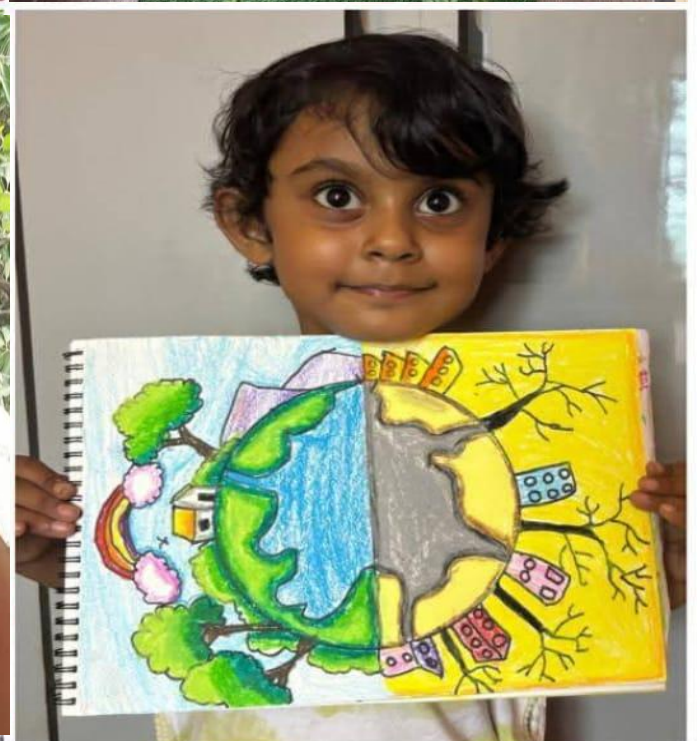

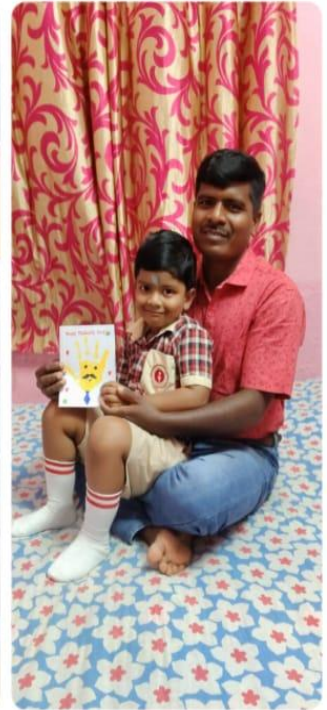
FATHER'S DAY

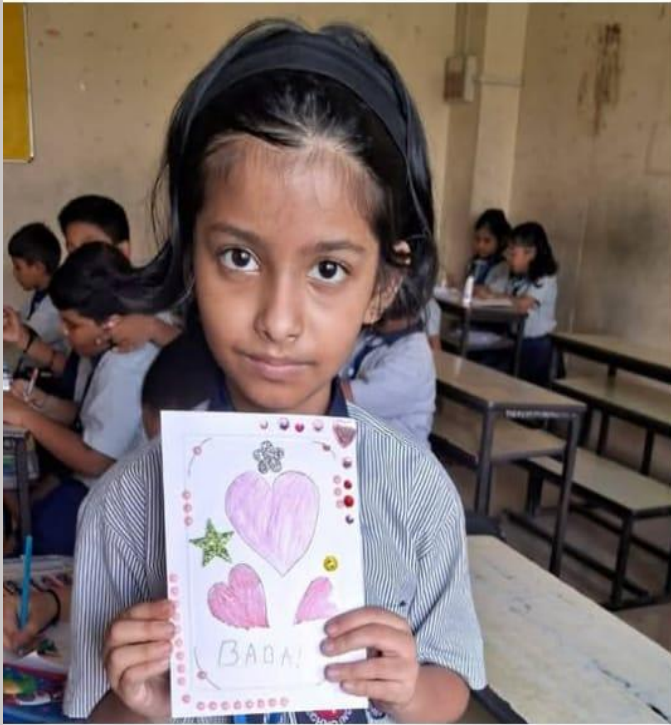
15 JUNE 2025

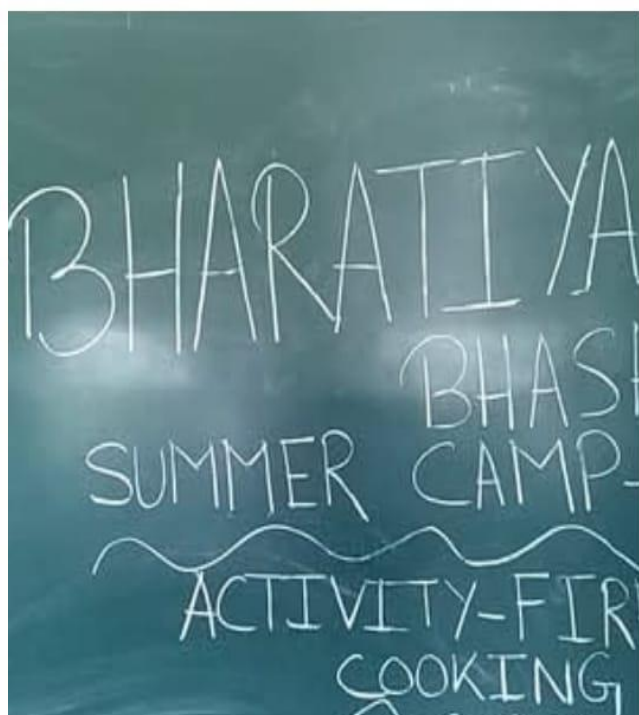

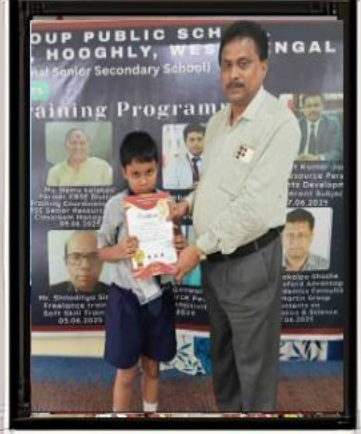

PSYCHOLOGICAL SURVEY ON STUDENTS

*Psychological Survey on Student-Teacher Communication at Techno India Group Public School, Nabagram

At Techno India Group Public School, Nabagram, we believe in fostering a healthy and supportive learning environment. In a recent initiative, a Psychological Survey on Interpersonal Relationships and Communication Gaps between Students and Teachers was conducted — led and compiled by our Class XII Psychology students, with inputs from students, teachers, our respected Principal, the School Counselor, and the PGT Psychology.

Key Findings:

- Many students admitted they often hesitate to share their concerns due to the fear of being judged or gossiped about.
- Teachers observed absenteeism and a lack of openness among students as key hurdles in building strong connections.
- The Principal emphasized that trust is a two-way process, and both students and teachers must contribute equally to strengthen their bond.
- The School Counselor recommended open-talk sessions and confidentiality training to make students feel safe and heard.

*The PGT Psychology suggested strategies like rapport-building activities, use of non-verbal communication, and positive reinforcement.

Conclusion:

The survey highlighted that mutual respect, empathy, and consistent efforts from both students and teachers are essential to bridge communication gaps and promote a positive, inclusive school environment.

Kudos to our Class XII Psychology students for this insightful initiative that not only promotes awareness but also encourages real change!

Simple Tips to Help Your Child Improve English Naturally

1. Make English a Part of Daily Life

2. Read Together, Regularly

- Read English storybooks aloud with your child.
