
CO-CURRICULAR: A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES



➤ FLN Ambassador Felicitation and Investiture Ceremony (02.09.2023)

➤ Janmashtami Celebration (06.09.2023)





Let's keep the spirit of Hindi alive and thriving!




➤ Ganesh Chaturthi Celebration (19.09.2023)

CONSEQUENCES OF CORPORAL PUNISHMENT
 NCPCH
 Punishment in any form or kind comes in the way of development of the full potential of children
 They grow up into angry adults and angry parents
 It leads to prime physical, psychological and educational outcomes
 Increased aggression, destructive and disruptive behavior, vandalism, poor school adjustment, increased absenteeism, school avoidance and school phobia, low self-esteem, anxiety, somatic complaints, depression, suicide and rebellion against teachers
 Victims prefer aggressive conflict resolution strategies with peers and siblings and they do not consider it a violation of their rights
 The best options lead to aggression and depression
Punishment DOES NOT EQUAL Discipline
 Depression
 Low self-esteem
 Behavioral problems
 Combinations of verbal abuse and emotional neglect lead to produce the most powerful negative outcomes

Provisions Under Juvenile Justice (care & protection of children) act 2000
 Section 19 of the Juvenile Justice Act gives the government the power to order a child to be placed in a shelter or a home up to 18 years of age.
 If the child is placed in a shelter or a home, the government may order up to 18 years.
 Section 20 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2000
 "Child protection" means the subjecting of a child to any person or persons who are not fit to be entrusted with the care and protection of a child, or for the purpose of disciplining or reforming the child.
 Section 21 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2000
 Order to prevent or remove a child from a shelter or a home, it requires the government to ensure that the child is placed in a shelter or a home which would be safe, healthy, and provide the best interests of the child, which would be in the best interests of the child, which would be in the best interests of the child, which would be in the best interests of the child.

Indian Penal Code (IPC)
 Section 305: Abetment of suicide committed by a child.
 Section 323: Voluntarily causing hurt,
 Section 325: Voluntarily causing grievous hurt;
 Section 326: Voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons or means;
 Section 352: Assault or use of criminal force otherwise than a grave provocation;
 Section 354: Outraging the modesty of a woman;
 Section 506: Criminal intimidation;
 Section 509: Word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman;

Constitutional Provisions
 Article 21 of the Constitution of India protects the right to life and dignity includes the right to education for children up to 14 years of age.
 Article 35(a) directs the State to work progressively to ensure that "the tender age of children are not abused".
 Article 39(f) directs the State to work progressively to ensure that children are given opportunities and facilities to develop in a healthy manner and in conditions of freedom and dignity and that childhood and youth are protected against exploitation and against moral and material abandonment.
