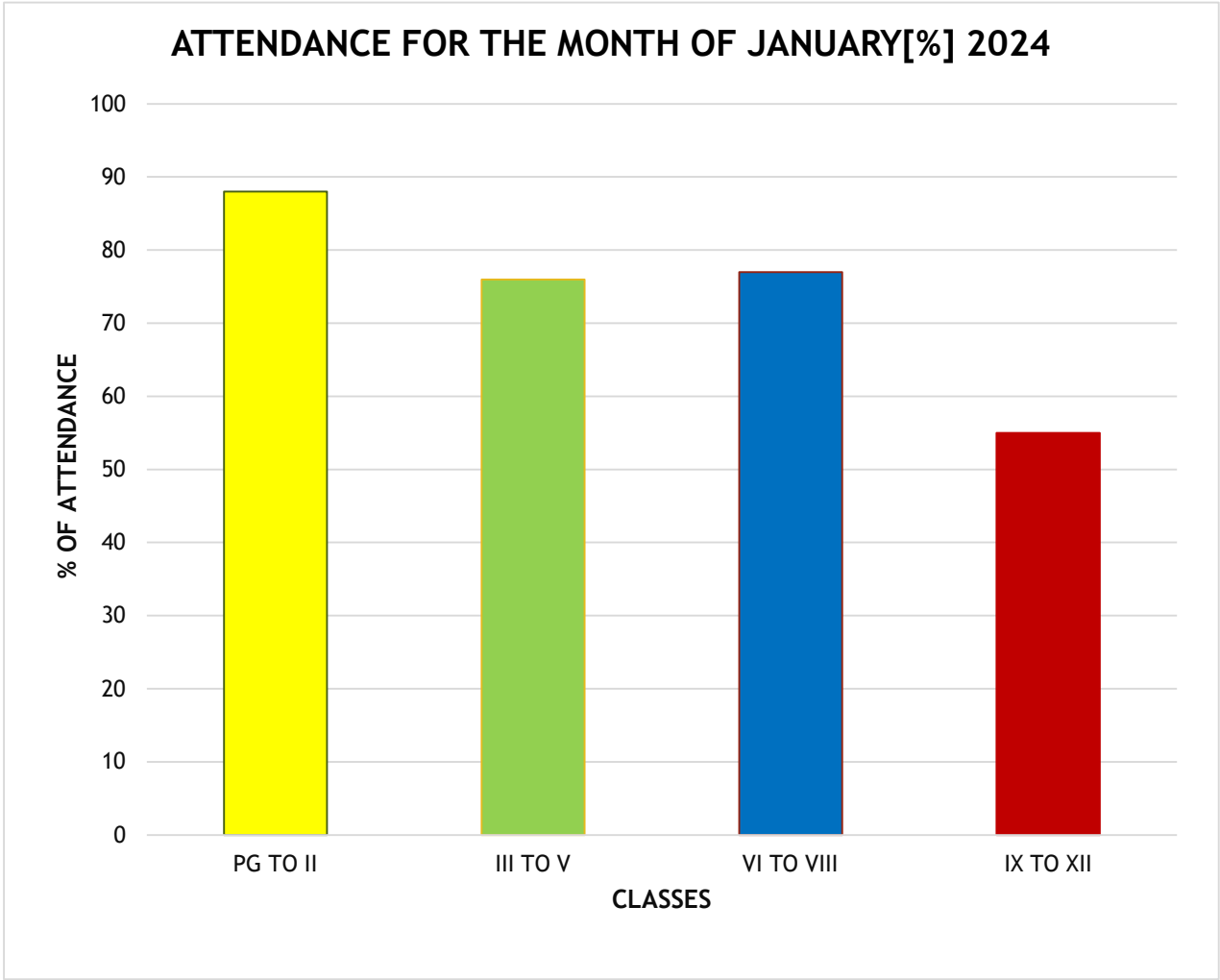
CO-CURRICULAR: A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES

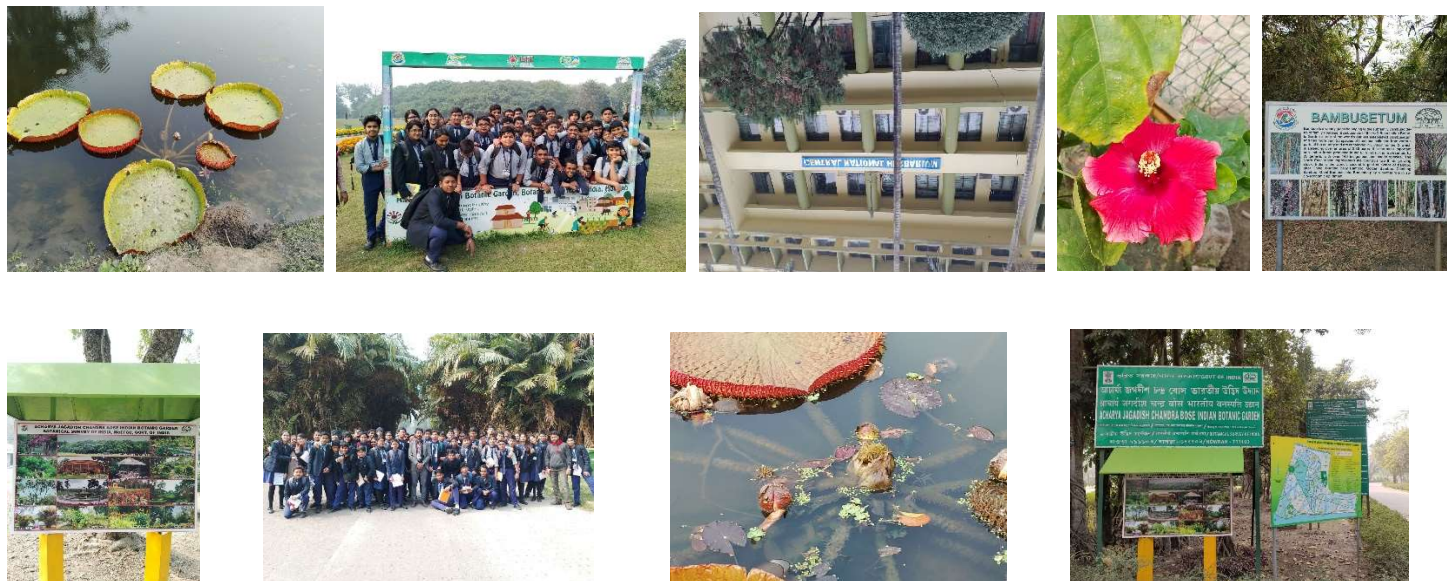
MENTAL MATHS ACTIVITY

NETAJI SUBHAS CHANDRA BOSE JAYANTI





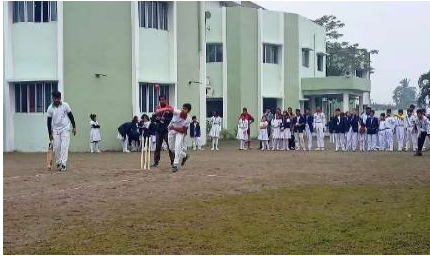
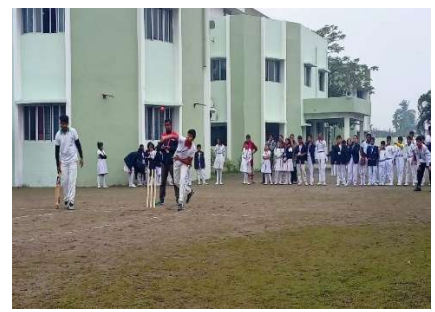
