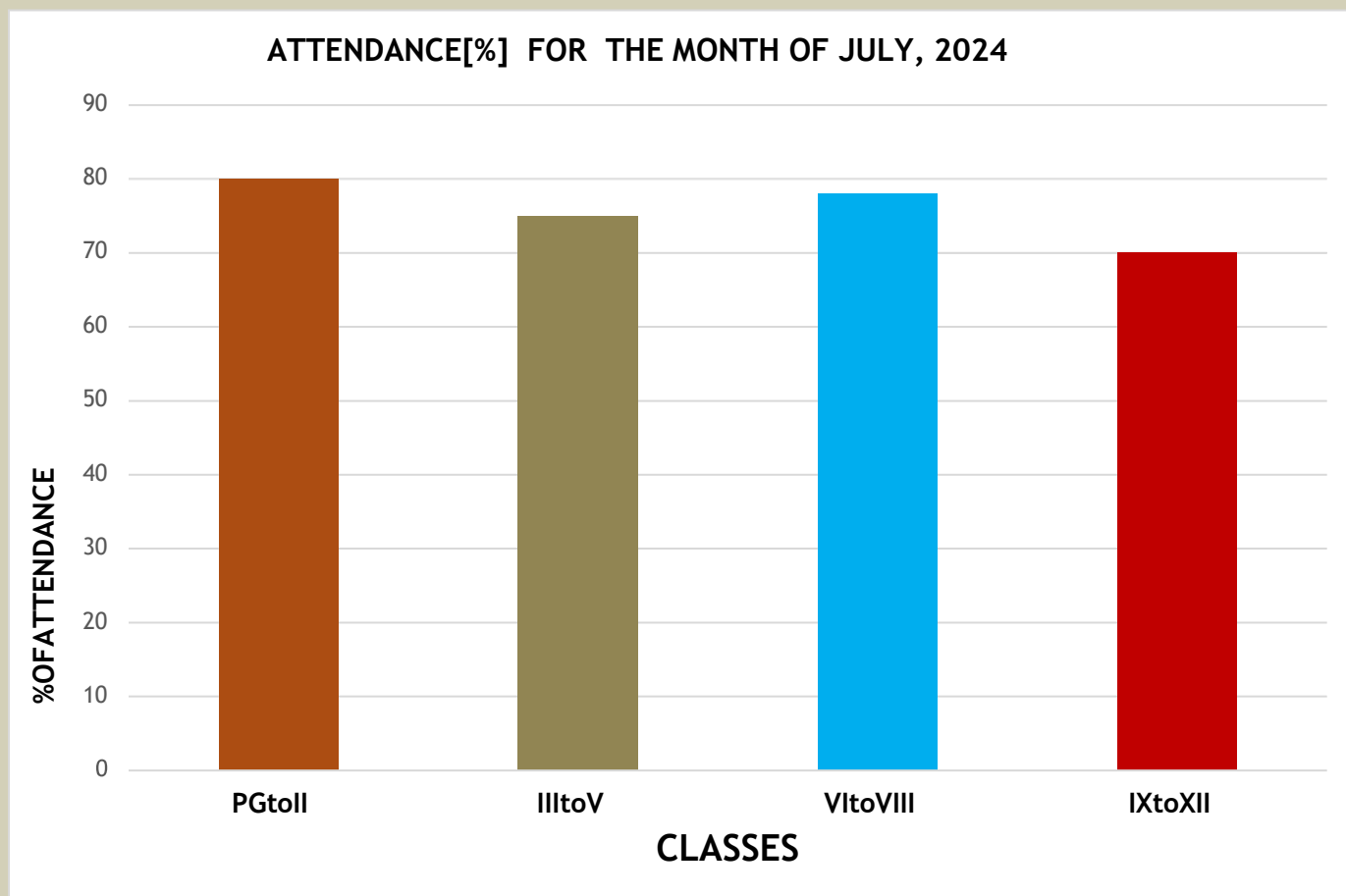
CO-CURRICULAR:A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES
