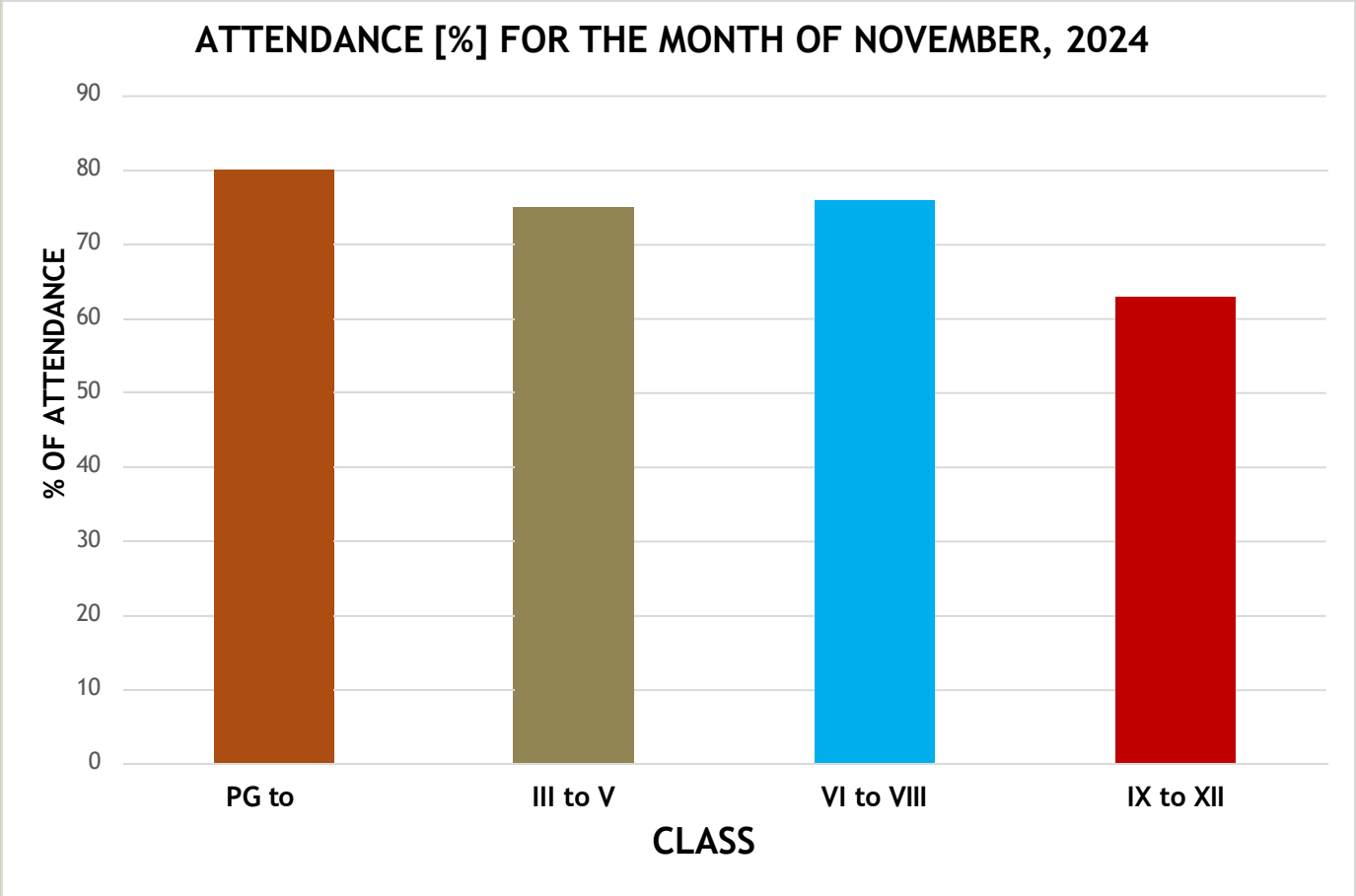
CO-CURRICULAR : A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITIES

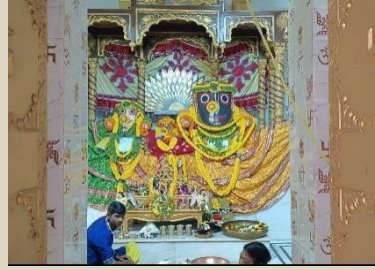


